PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. The months of July through Dec 1979 were serried with events that kept the Bn moving at a rapid pace. Operational commitments ran the gamut of working with agencies of the Marine Air Command and Control Community to tests with the United States Air Force.

2. The second half of 1979 started on an inspection note. Included in these inspections were embarkation inspections that marked the way for operational readiness evaluations for all three firing batteries. A Marine Corps Disbursing On Site Examination Team inspection found the Bn's performance significantly improved with H&S Btry receiving an O/S. Battery B followed it's ORE with participation in W/TI 2-79, which provided excellent operational training. While Btry B supported WTI,Col D. J. VERDON visited the Bn. On 27 Aug Btry A began the new IHAWK Product Improvement Program implementation and equipment training. By 19 Dec all three firing batteries were PIP equipped and trained. September started Battery C's 4 month participation in the Cruise Missile Survivability Test conducted at Dugway Proving Grounds, Utah. Battery C's performance proved effective in identifying cruise missile vulnerabilities. The Redeve Mission Performance Standards presented at the Marine Corps Combat Readiness Evaluation System conference by our representative were viewed as impressive and a valuable contribution to establishing volume VIII of MCCRES. The FMFPac inspection held in Sep found the Battalion ready and on course. October was highlighted by a visit by the Commandant and the SGTMAJ of the Marine Corps. Brig General C. L. COMFORT, the assistant Wing Commander, toured the Bn during the beginning of Nov. Btry A conducted operations with MACS-7 and subsequently wrote an SOP for joint LAAM/MACS ATDL-1 operations. December proved one of the busier months. It began with the Bn briefing Lt Generals W. J. WHITE, DCS Aviation and A. W. O'DONNELL CG, FMFPac. Btry A then combined an ORE, MCCRES support for HMM-268, evaluation of the SIMTRACC System and a FIREX at Raven Butte. Our Redeye teams participated in a FIREX at 29 Palms, CA. Battery B brought the year to a close by evaluating VX-5, based at China Lake, on its ECM and tactical capabilities when performing against IHAWK.
